MEMBERSHIP FAQs

How do I transfer tickets/parking/priority points?

You may transfer seats as a benefit of your Capital Gift Agreement (CGA) in football and men's basketball and your personal seat license (PSL) in baseball. Seats not covered by a CGA or PSL may be transferred by completion of a transfer form and a transfer fee of \$250 per seat. Parking is not transferable because it is reallocated annually. Priority points are not transferable because they are a measure of past support of Ole Miss Athletics.

How are away game and neutral site tickets allocated?

Tickets are allocated based on priority, availability and donor level. All ticket requests are ranked based on priority points immediately following the posted deadline. To determine your ticket eligibility, please view the annual fund benefits chart on page 5. Members are assigned the best available seats as provided by the host site based on priority points. No refunds or exchanges will be issued based on location.

How are season ticket and parking requests allocated?

New season tickets, move requests and gameday parking for football, men's basketball and baseball are allocated based on priority points and availability. All ticket requests are ranked based on priority points immediately following the posted deadlines and assigned a specific timeslot for OleMissSeats.com. Members may choose from any available location at their assigned time.

Are giving plans available?

The Ole Miss Athletics Foundation offers a flexible monthly giving option for members to make their donations. All giving plans with the Ole Miss Athletics Foundation must be completed by December 15, 2018. Please call 662-915-7159 for more information. It is Ole Miss Athletics Foundation policy to hold tickets and parking for all accounts that fall behind on any giving plans.

What forms of payment are available?

The Ole Miss Athletics Foundation accepts cash, check, credit card, ACH fund transfers, and gifts of stock.

Do I have to be a season ticket holder to join the Ole Miss Athletics Foundation?

No. Regardless of whether or not you can attend athletic events your support allows us to continue giving Rebel student-athletes the highest quality experience.

Is my gift tax-deductible?

According to the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act signed into law on December 22, 2017, Internal Revenue Code Section 170(I) has been amended to eliminate charitable deductions previously allowed for donations given for seating in athletics venues. Priority seating per-seat donations will not be deductible for tax purposes. Philanthropic giving beyond seating donations are still tax-deductible. Please consult with your tax advisor for information on how these changes affect your personal income taxes.

Examples of philanthropic giving include: Vaught Society, 110% Campaign, Forward Together and above and beyond membership giving.



Is my donation refundable?

Donations and season ticket purchases are not refundable.

PRIORITY POINTS

The Ole Miss Athletics Foundation priority point system recognizes and rewards those donors who have committed to the long term success of Ole Miss Athletics. Priority points are used to rank donors for new season ticket and parking allocations, away games, bowl games and NCAA postseason events. Points are accumulated through the following means:

- One point for every \$100 donated to the Ole Miss Athletics Foundation since 1998.
- One point for every season ticket (up to 10 per year) since 1998 for football, men's and women's basketball, and baseball.


Priority points are updated before any major allocations such as NCAA tournaments, away games, bowl games, etc. Points are credited only as donations are received. Making your donation by March 31 means you will receive priority point credit for the entire amount of the gift, which could improve your selection for seats and/or parking for football.

Those interested in upgrading seats to a club area should review availability during their selection time slot. All season tickets in the South End Zone Club and Rebel Club require an initial buy-in in the first year. Selection opportunities are ranked by priority points. (See page 8 for more information on priority points.)


GAMEDAY PARKING

Gameday parking is reallocated annually for football, men's basketball and baseball. Donors select their parking location(s) online at OleMissSeats.com. No parking location is guaranteed; all parking selections are based on priority and availability. The following criteria will govern all parking assignments:

- 1. You must request parking passes with your season ticket renewal by completing the necessary information with your ticket order.
- **2.** Requests should be received by the appropriate deadlines of March 31 for football, July 31 for men's basketball and September 30 for baseball.
- **3.** All parking requests received after the deadline will be placed on a waitlist. (If there are any parking passes available after the initial selection process has finished, they will be assigned based on priority points.)
- **4.** Donors will be eligible to request season parking passes based on their annual seating commitment for each sport using the criteria below:

ADA Parking

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Office of Civil Rights, parking is expressly prohibited on sidewalks, roadsides, grass and other areas that prevent appropriate access and consideration to pedestrians, wheelchairs and other forms of access. The University of Mississippi and the City of Oxford will strictly enforce these parking regulations. The University of Mississippi provides all on-campus ADA stalls as well as additional parking for home athletics events. In order to park in an ADA stall on gameday for football, men's basketball and baseball, you must display your state-issued ADA credential and the appropriate gameday parking pass for the specific parking lot in which you are attempting to park. Failure to display both credentials may result in citation and/or tow at owner's expense.

Babic Zvonimir will be entering his senior season as an Ole Miss men's tennis student-athlete this fall. Prior to attending Ole Miss, Zvonimir was ranked No. 1 in Croatia in juniors, won the Croatian National Indoor Championship in singles and the Outdoor Championship in doubles.

Since arriving at Ole Miss, Zvonimir has added two top-30 doubles finishes to his career accolades, as well as three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In the classroom, Zvonimir has been named to the Chancellor's Honor Roll (awarded to all students with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and above) four times and the SEC Spring Academic Honor in both of his first two seasons.

After graduating next May, Zvonimir plans to pursue a career in Oxford under the Optional Practical Training program, or further his education by pursuing a master's in Accounting.

Student-Athletes Snapshot

Hannah Christen enters her junior season on the track and just completed her senior season in cross country.


Christen was one of the top Rebels on the cross country course this past fall, helping lead Ole Miss to their first-ever South Region title and their second-ever (and second consecutive) NCAA berth. The Rebel women finished 25th, the second-straight top-25 team finish for Ole Miss, in just their second trip to the national meet.

Individually, Christen earned All-South Region honors after finishing 13th at the regional meet. On the track last season (her first at Ole Miss), Christen was an NCAA Regional qualifier in the 5K, where she finished 35th.

Academically, Christen has landed on the Chancellor's Honor Roll (awarded to all students with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and above) every semester since arriving in Oxford. She also was named to the SEC First Year Academic Honor Roll in 2016-17 and to the USTFCCCA 2017 All-Academic Team in August 2017.

Following graduation, Hannah plans to attend nursing school.
