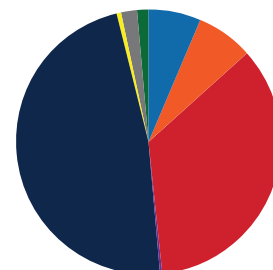

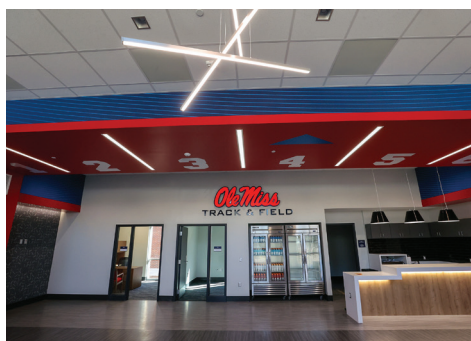

## FOOTBALL

- Finished 10-3 overall and ended the season ranked No. 11 in the country earning a spot in the 2022 Sugar Bowl.
- Finished the 2021 campaign with a perfect 7-0 home record, its first undefeated season at home (on the field) since 1992.



## SOCCER

- Finished season 12-6-3 and received a bid to the NCAA Championship for the 10th time in program history.
- Made it to semifinals of SEC Tournament, the deepest run since 2013.



## CROSS COUNTRY

- Women's team finished 10th at 2021 NCAA Cross Country Championships, their first top-10 national finish in program history.
- Men's team finished 15th overall at 2021 NCAA Cross Country Championships.



## VOLLEYBALL

- Finished season 21-9 (.700), the fourth-best winning percentage in program history.
- Earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in program history, first time since 2010.
- Saw a 67.4 winning percentage increase from last season, the best turnaround in D1.
